All to report back to next year's conference...

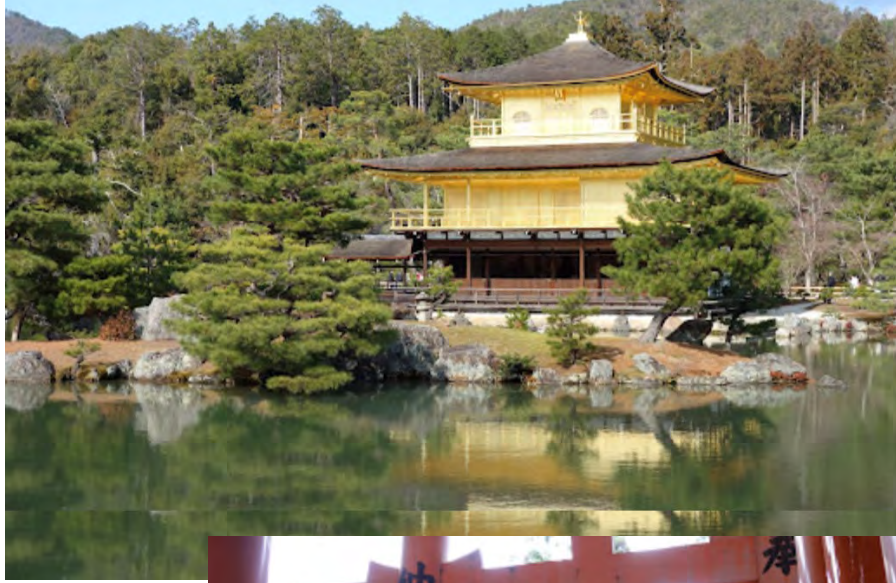
